SPECIAL COMMUNITIES

A few of our residence halls are home to special communities that give residents the opportunity to integrate their academic pursuits and interests with their living arrangements (Lynch and Hawthorn Halls: freshmen learning communities; Witherspoon Hall: International House, Global Gateways and Transfer Students Community; Greek Village: Sororities; Levine Hall: University Honors and Levine Scholars; Holshouser Hall: ROTC Community; Pine Hall: graduate students and post-traditional students). We have gender affirming housing options in various halls. Additionally, we designate spaces in Martin Hall and Independent Greek Village Houses for residents to live with their pet.

ALL-INCLUSIVE RATES

Our per semester rates are all-inclusive and consist of rent, laundry, all utilities, cable TV, high-speed wired and wireless internet. As an on campus resident, your per semester rate also includes membership in the Resident Student Association (RSA), a student-run organization that helps us deliver social and academic-related programs to all of our residents.

MEAL PLANS

All freshmen residents, regardless of where they live, are required to purchase a meal plan. All residents of traditional and suite housing are required to purchase a meal plan. Upper class residents living in apartments and Greek Village may choose a meal plan, but are not required to purchase one. Meal plan fees are not included in the Housing rates.
