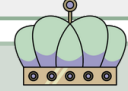
NINER CHOICE TASKFORCE SPOTLIGHT

Know Your Dates

Stay aware of your lease dates! Most off-campus leases are fixed-term, meaning you're responsible for the full duration once you sign. In most cases, breaking a lease is not possible unless it falls under the few specific exceptions allowed in North Carolina (which are rare). Be sure your move-in and move-out plans align before committing.

Stay Alert

Set reminders for key lease dates, such as renewal deadlines and notice periods. Many leases require advance notice, and missing those deadlines could result in additional fees.

*"I am the Program Director of Basic Needs Services. Basic Needs Services supports students through our **Swipe Out Hunger** Program as well as the Jamil Niner Student Pantry. Swipe Out Hunger applications can be found on our website, ninerpantry.charlotte.edu. We reward 150 students with 20 meal swipes each per semester."*

How can off-campus students access resources like the Jamil Niner Student Pantry, and when should they reach out for support?

*"Jamil Niner Student Pantry is open for appointments on Tuesday and Thursday from 11 am - 4:45 pm, and on Wednesday for walk-ins from 11 am - 3 pm. We also have a **To Go Bag** Program, and if students have interest, they can email us at ninerpantry.charlotte.edu. If you or someone you know is experiencing food insecurity or just wants to come and see what we have to offer, we always encourage shoppers to sign up for an appointment or come and see us on a walk-in day."*
