





What advice would you give students pursuing off-campus living when navigating leases, responsibilities, & potential challenges?

Advice I would give students pursuing off-campus living is to always read the lease before signing it. While lease agreements can be long and tedious, they are contracts, and anything you sign means you agree to the terms and conditions, so it's important to know what you're saying yes to. Our office offers lease reviews to help before you sign. Additionally, if you experience maintenance or habitability issues, report them to the leasing office through proper channels as soon as possible so they are aware and can resolve them.
