What is a piece of advice for students transitioning to off-campus, and how does your team help residents navigate that successfully?

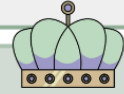

Nope! UNC Charlotte and Housing and Residence Life do not own or manage any Niner Choice properties. Rather, the Niner Choice Program is a partnership between the University and the properties, giving students safe, housing options with student-focused living options.

Can I pay my rent through my UNC Charlotte Student Portal?

No. Each property is individually owned and managed, and have their own portal for paying rent, utilities, or other fees. When you sign your lease, you will be informed of what platform is used for payments.

What are some of the best ways or unique opportunities the Leadership & Community Engagement Office provides to help off-campus students stay deeply engaged with the college community?

"There are many ways to engage in the campus community through our office! The students can choose to engage in one of our leadership cohort programs, such as Emerging Leaders (first-year students) or Leadership Fellows (Sophomore Year & Above). Additionally, if students have a busy schedule, they can participate in our PILOT non-academic certificate program, which awards them credit for attending certain university events and workshops. Lastly, if students wish to engage in community service, they can attend SERVE team events, which are held weekly around campus and in the greater Charlotte community. For a student living off-campus, what is the easiest first step to get involved with your office's community engagement programs?

"The easiest first step is to follow our Instagram page (CLT_Lead) and join Niner Engage, and follow SERVE team!
