## MEAL PLANS

All first-year residents, regardless of where they live, are required to purchase a meal plan. All residents of traditional and suite housing are required to purchase a meal plan. Upperclass residents living in apartments and Greek Village may choose a meal plan, but are not required to purchase one. Meal plan fees are not included in the Housing rates.
